

2010 Futurity Rules and Requirements

Breeder's Weanling: A foal produced from stallion that was in the 2009 stallion auction whose stud service was sold in the auction. The stallion owner receives one free entry. All foals produced from this stallion in 2010 are eligible and the entry fee is \$50. The Futurity Committee may divide the class by horse and pony, if there is enough entries to do so.

Early Weanling: A foal born between January 1 and April 30, 2010. Class will be split only, IF there are 5 or more entries.

Late Weanling: A foal born between May 1, 2010, and date of the Futurity Show. Mares may be led in with foals and lined up in front of or behind foals. There will be two handlers. Both animals must wear halters and be led in. Class will be split only, IF there are 5 or more entries.

Yearling: A horse/pony born between January 1 and December 31, 2009.

Two-Year Old: A horse/pony born between January 1 and December 31, 2008.

Pony: A foal that is *expected* to mature to a height of 56 inches and under, height of that pony breed's current standards and/or is generally considered to be a pony breed including Miniatures.

Horse: A foal that is *expected* to mature to a height over 56 and/or is generally considered to be a horse breed. *If one or both parents are of horse size or breeding, the foal is to be considered a horse unless deemed a pony by the Futurity Committee and/or the Board of Directors. If there is any question as to which category a horse/pony goes into the decision will be made by the Futurity Committee and/or the Board of Directors.*

Maturity Halter: A horse/pony born on or after January 1, 2007, and has previously or currently been nominated for the QCABHA Futurity. This class may be split at the discretion of the Futurity Committee.

Halter: All horses/ponies must be led in by a halter or bridle according to their specific breed and/or type. To be judged on confirmation and movement. All animals will be judged in accordance with specific breed standards in mind.

Lounge Line: This class is open to yearlings, two and three year olds that have not been ridden. Horse/pony to be shown in a halter with a lounge line. This class will be judged on movement, manners, and confirmation with specific breed standards in mind.

Futurity Walk/Trot: This class is open to two, three, four, and five year olds that have NOT been ridden in a show before January 1, 2010. All horses/ponies are to be ridden with two hands. If riding western may show in a snaffle or bosal. If riding hunt seat may show in a snaffle. If riding saddle seat may show in a full/Weymouth bridle or snaffle with two reins and running martingale. IF riding saddle seat for gaited horse such as a TN Walker may ride with a broken curb or tom thumb type bit. Each horse/pony will be shown in correct bit for its seat and breed. Not eligible for Futurity Pleasure class.

Futurity Pleasure: This class is open to two, three, four, five, and six year olds that have NOT been cantered in a riding class at a show before January 1, 2010, and/or were eligible for walk/trot performance class the year before. All horses/ponies are to be ridden with two hands. If riding western may show in a snaffle or bosal. If riding hunt seat may show in a snaffle. If riding saddle seat may show in a full/Weymouth bridle or snaffle with two reins and running

martingale. IF riding saddle seat for gaited horse may ride with a broken curb or tom thumb type bit. Each horse/pony will be shown in correct bit for its seat and breed. Not eligible for Futurity Walk/Trot or Maturity Pleasure class.

Maturity Pleasure: This class is open to three year olds (born on or after January 1, 2007) and up that has previously or currently been nominated for QCABHA Futurity. This class may be split at the discretion of the Futurity Committee. Each horse/pony will be shown in correct bit for its seat and breed. IF riding western horse/pony 5 years and under may be shown in a snaffle or bosal. Not eligible for Futurity Walk/Trot or Pleasure.

Futurity Driving: This class is open to two, three, four, and five year olds that have NOT been driven in a show before January 1, 2010. Not eligible for Maturity Driving.

Maturity Driving: This class is open to three year olds (born on or after January 1, 2007) and up that has previously or currently been nominated for QCABHA Futurity. This class may be split at the discretion of the Futurity Committee. Not eligible for Futurity Driving class.

General Rules:

1. All exhibitors must be a member in good standing with QCABHA and all entries (horse/pony) must be owned by a member in good standing.
2. All fees including entry, buy-in, and late fees must be paid with entry form. Any check received by QCABHA Futurity not honored at the bank will assessed the bank charge of \$30.
3. Work requirements (4 hours minimum) to be fulfilled on or before the August 2010 show or if you live 75 miles or more you may by out your work requirement for \$50. The work time may be split between regular or youth QCABHA shows. If you are having someone work in your place, a Futurity Committee member must be made aware of it. Please sign-up ahead time with either Futurity or Show Committee. You must check-in and out by signing the sheet at the entry booth with either Futurity or Show Committee on the day you have selected. If you do not fulfill your work requirements, you will forfeit any futurity money awarded to you.
4. All stallions must be exhibited by handler/rider 18 years or older.
5. All re-nominations must be turned-in, paid for and post marked on or before July 1, 2010. There will be a late fee for any nominations post marked after July 1, 2010. *No entries accepted after August 1, 2010.*
6. Complete Futurity Show rules are available in the current edition QCABHA rule book.
7. All suggestions and complaints shall be submitted in written form such as hand written, typed, or e-mailed to be considered and submitted to committee chair. All other forms will be refused.
8. All horses/ponies entered must meet current health requirements of Iowa State law.
9. The Futurity Committee reserves the right to divide any class as needed for safety reasons, 5 or more entries, etc.... The class may be divided by horse/pony, breed types, age, etc...
