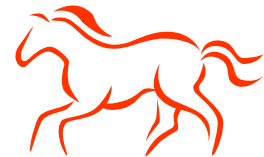
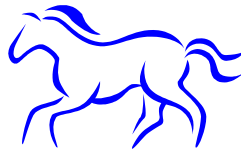
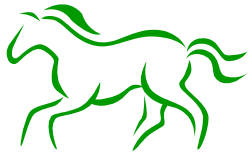
Show Committee News

Horse of a Different Color Answer:

That would be Nu Twist on Cash (a.k.a. Twizzler). She is an AQHA 2009 filly by Kansas City Twister (Grullo) and out of JC Cash Deposit (Buckskin).

Twizzler was born with coloring like a brown mule (dark brown body and a light tan/brown muzzle). Then her baby hair shed out and she was looking quite “blue”. So I sent in her registration papers as a Blue Roan. AQHA sent them back and said “No”, she was a bay roan. I told them there wasn’t a red hair in her body. After many pictures back and forth and now her winter hair coming in nearly white, we were both quite befuddled. Twizzler started shedding out again this spring and I was still seeing blue/gray under her long white, winter fuzz. More pictures to AQHA. Now I have the attention of Ms. Debbie Black, AQHA Equine Color Specialist. On April 1st, we sent Twizzler’s DNA hair sample to UC Davis in California. It took them two months to come up with this color description.

She will be registered as: Buckskin “Carries and Expresses Roan Gene”. She is a Buckskin Roan and is homozygous for the black gene. This means she carries one crème dilution (N/Ccr), is heterozygous for the agouti gene (Aa) and two black genes (EE). Twizzler will never produce a “red” foal such as sorrel, chestnut, palomino, red roan, cremello, or red dun (if bred to a dun).

Her current color as of June 2010 is: Black legs to the knees; tan from the knees up to her lower chest, belly and lower rear end; gray/roan from her poll, neck, across her back, down the sides and half way down her rear end; head is dark brown with light brown muzzle; mane & tail are black.

I never knew that naming her “Nu Twist on Cash” would have so much meaning.

Horse/Pony and rider combination together never having won two (2) performance first place ribbons, including non-QCABHA shows.

A win in walk/trot does not exclude exhibitors from being eligible for novice pleasure classes. See Rule book for clarification.

Did ya Ever Wonder...

What do some of our QCABHA members do when they're not playing with horses?



Meet Ronda Johnson and Cody of Davenport, IA. Most of the time, you know Ronda and Cody, Appaloosa/Quarter Horse cross at the horse shows. They show in halter, showmanship and pleasure classes. They also enjoy camping and trail riding. The rest of the time, Ronda is an ER nurse at Trinity Terrace Park Hospital, where she works full-time and also teaches some nursing classes. In between those three things, she found some time to spend two weeks in Haiti helping out the earthquake victims.

“Hey Everyone. Just wanted to say Thank You to everyone who helped us with our mission to Haiti. I went with Project Helping Hands and a friend and co-worker went as well. We did field medicine in tent camps who hadn’t had any medical care since the quake. We would find areas of greatest need and set up a field hospital with the tents and tarps we took with us. We hauled all of our supplies we brought and saw an average of 170 patients daily with 8 nurses, 1 CNA, 1 school teacher and 1 engineering student.

People would walk for hours in the heat and stand in line for help, it was very sad. The Haitian people are still starving to death as the early and largest amount of donations were given to the government of Haiti. We saw food sitting in warehouses waiting to be sold to the highest bidder. There is little to no clean-up or rebuilding because again, it is in the hands of the government. Entire families are living under bed sheets tied to sticks to protect them from the elements. It rains everyday at some point, usually at night and the day time temps hover around 100 degrees. Because of the generosity of our friends, families and co-workers we were able to make a difference in some of the suffering.”

Who is that Masked Man? That would be Jim Meldrum. Jim owns his own company IESMC, Inc. that teaches OSHA HazMat Safety Training and is based in Milan, IL. Generally, he has monthly classes in the Chicago area and occasionally travels to other parts of the U.S. and Canada to do on-site safety training. For the past few weeks, however, he has been in the Gulf of Mexico area teaching hundreds of potential employees and volunteers for the oil spill clean-up. Students are taught how to safely wear a respirator and what personal protective equipment is needed to keep them safe from the oil, the oil dispersant, heat stress/stroke, water hazards and biological hazards such as bugs and snakes. It’s been a busy few weeks for Jim, but he seems to thrive on the stress, activities and challenges he is facing.

When Jim isn’t out playing in nasty petroleum or chemical contaminated areas, he enjoys his riding and driving time with his Quarter Horse gelding Butch.

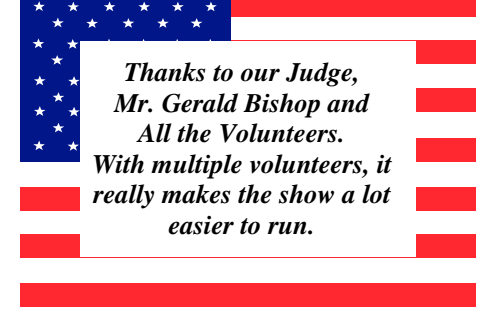
